**FOR COMPLETION OF THE CERTIFICATE, STUDENTS MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:**

1. Declare their intention to complete the certificate and develop a plan of study in by completing the [online form](#).
2. Choose which certificate track you intend to follow:
  - Complete four courses selected from the list of elective courses.
  - Complete three courses selected from the list elective courses and participate in at least one practicum to be approved by an Anthropology or IB advisor.
3. Complete the [online checklist](#) no later than the final day of classes in the student’s final term to affirm that the requirements for the certificate have been met.

Students opting to complete the certificate with a practicum must receive approval from an IB advisor prior to undertaking the practicum. Options for a practicum may include, but are not limited to, the following: volunteering, research, experience abroad, internships, or job shadowing. Practicums should comprise at least twenty supervised hours of experience aligned with the certificate. Students need to complete the [online practicum approval form](#) prior to undertaking the experience.

Students completing the certificate will be presented with an official certificate document. Although the certificate will not appear on a student’s transcript, students will be free to use this credential on any resumé or application for advanced study.

*Students are not guaranteed a seat in a course required by the certificate but are welcome to enroll in courses where seats are available after any restriction, which may have been placed, has been removed.  
 Courses selected may not be used to satisfy requirements of more than one Anthropology or IB Certificate.*
